3. Include resume or bio & artist statement.
4. Completed Entry Form. Keep a copy of this form for your records.
5. Artists will be notified by 8/31/2010
6. **Please note: Prepaid shipping for the return of artwork is required. Details upon acceptance. ALL works must be shipped via Fed Ex, UPS or DHL. Not USPO!**
8. **NO ENTRY FEE BUT THERE WILL BE A HANGING FEE OF \$30.96 OR 25 EUROS PER ACCEPTED PIECE.**

Size Specifications:

2-D: no larger than 60" x 60" in either direction

3-D: All sculpture must be free standing unless artist supplies pedestal or other means of support.

TERMS:

Insurance: The responsibility for damage or loss at **all times, however caused**, rests with the artist, who is therefore advised to arrange adequate insurance against these and any other risks. Each artist must obtain his/her own insurance policy against theft or damage if desired. The Society for Art of Imagination, its staff, members and the Murphy Hill Gallery and its staff are not responsible for damages for the duration of the exhibit.

Installation: Accepted Artwork must be delivered during the week of 10/20-10/27 (details upon acceptance). Accepted artwork must be delivered "ready to hang" in a professional manner. All works on paper must be framed (no clip frames) & under **Plexiglass**. Wall-hung work will be installed by hanging wire. Accepted artwork must remain on view for the duration of the exhibition.

Copyright: Copyright of all work remains the property of the artist. Any inquiries will be referred to the artist.

Care of Works: All works will be handled with care. In the event of work being lost, destroyed or damaged the events organizers liability shall not exceed the value of the work as stated on entry form (less 40%) or any altered price subsequently notified to the organizers. The exhibition organizers shall not be bound by the price stated on the entry form and in the event of any dispute arising as to the amount of any such loss or damage, whether or not liability is disputed, the dispute shall be referred to arbitration, an independent expert valuer to be chosen by agreement between the parties, provided always that the arbitrator's award shall not exceed the exhibition organizers' maximum liability in accordance with sub-paragraph hereof. The arbitrator's award shall be final and shall be conclusive evidence of the amount of the loss. The artist shall not be entitled to begin or maintain any action at law in respect of loss until the arbitrator shall have made a determination in accordance with the terms of this sub-paragraph and then only for the amount so awarded. The submission of the entry form is to be taken as the unreserved acceptance of the entire contents of these conditions and those on the form.

Sales: There will be a 30% commission for the gallery on sales. Your price should reflect that percentage.
